This is the second special Website-only addition of the regular monthly Newsletter for the Traditional Latin Mass congregation. If the church should be opened again for Holy Mass in May, then we will replace this E-edition immediately into a paper edition including, the Mass schedule. In this E-edition, we bring you mostly news items and suggestions to continue fostering your spiritual life.

1. LiveMass.net

LiveMass.net is an apostolate of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter (F.S.S.P.). The website streams the Tridentine Latin Mass five times each weekday and eight times each Sunday. In

addition to Masses, the website also occasionally streams compline, vespers, and a Holy Hour. An exact schedule can be found on the website. Select a time which best suits you and your family members as there are Masses starting at different times. All of them are rendered as Pacific Time, which is our time zone.

You can also watch Masses that are not **live** broadcasts and that can be viewed on YouTube or Vimeo at a time that is best suited to your personal or family needs. We recommend that you the following link of the Institute of Christ the King, Sovereign Priests (I.C.R.) in Gricigliano where our seminarian Abbé Julian Malinowski is studying <https://www.icrsp.org/direct/> The Missa Cantata on Sundays is very beautiful. It includes a number of altar servers and a small choir. There is no sermon, but a separate link is provided of a sermon in the French language. This may be of interest to our French speaking parishioners. There are also Masses from other countries, including Spain, Germany, and U.S.A. Apart from Masses, there are Vespers and devotional prayers, including Rosaries.

2. News for our choristers (and others interested in learning to chant Vespers)

“Following the March 15th webinar on monastic Compline, I’m offering a 4-part series on chanting monastic Vespers, for which I will be joined by Dom Benedict Andersen of [Silverstream Priory](#) in Ireland. We will spend 40 minutes learning, and then chant Vespers together. Each week will cover a new topic, and it’s not necessary to join each week, though the information shared will be cumulative throughout the series. A Vespers booklet with all the music (Gregorian chant, and an English adaptation of the chants for personal use) will be shared with all participants.”
