NEWS

1. BROWN SCAPULARS

Mrs. Ellie Raeder has a source for Scapulars. These Scapulars are larger than normal, handmade and embroidered. You can choose from two different embroidered emblems for each one. The cost \$10.00 for each Scapular.



2. Note: This is the fourth special Website-only addition of the regular monthly Newsletter for the Traditional Latin Mass congregation. We still are not permitted to bring printed copies into the church. When this ruling is removed, we will promptly make printed copies available again. However, you are permitted to bring your own **Daily Missal**. Please contact Mrs. Raeder if you wish to order a copy of Daily Missal or of a children's Missal.

3. Mass Schedule

Masses start at 8.00 a.m. on all weekdays (except Saturdays when there is **usually** no Latin Mass), and at 8.00 a.m. and noon on Sundays. In August there will be a Mass on the following Saturdays: August 1, 7, 15, and possibly 22 (the last to be confirmed on our website).

Please note that the schedule on page 1 permits us to list only Friday, Sunday and special feastdays Masses. It may be discontinued from the next Newsletter onward and replaced with a weekly Mass schedule on our website.

4. Mass Propers

For those who have no *Daily Missal* we recommend that you print copy the Mass Propers, including Commemorations, if any from the following web site: <https://tridentine-mass.blogspot.com/search/> They are posted daily at 12.30 a.m.

Note that Propers and Commemorations may not always match those used at the local parishes as Priests can on certain days choose to celebrate a different Mass, such as a votive Mass.

5. LiveMass.net

For those who prefer the safety of their home and follow a Latin Mass Livestreamed, we offer the following suggestions. (Note: *Livestreamed* Masses can be followed only at the time when celebrated)

[LiveMass.net](#) is an apostolate of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter (F.S.S.P.). The website streams the Tridentine Latin Mass five times each weekday and eight times each Sunday. In addition to Masses, the website also occasionally streams Vespers, Compline, and a Holy Hour. An exact schedule can be found on the website. Select a time which best suits you and your family members as there are Masses starting at different times. All of them are rendered as Pacific Time, which is our time zone.

We recommend that you click on the following link of the Institute of Christ the King, Sovereign Priests (I.C.R.S.P.) in Gricigliano where our seminarian Abbé Julian Malinowski is studying <https://www.icrsp.org/direct/> The Missa Cantata on Sundays is very beautiful. The Mass is assisted by a number of Altar servers and a small choir. There is no sermon, but a separate link is provided for a sermon in the French tongue. This Mass is not *livestreamed* and can be followed at a time of your convenience.)

6. Pro-Life and Pro-Family News

As you may, or may not, know, **the BC Provincial Government is in the process of compelling the Delta Hospice in British Columbia to commit euthanasia.**

The Delta Hospice Society (DHS) is a non-government provider of palliative care. The BC Government has ordered DHS to lethally inject patients or lose its operating funding and also lose their facility (which was built with private donations).

The DHS constitution respects the sanctity of human life. DHS refuses to kill residents in their care.

In order to remain euthanasia free, **the DHS needs to have, at the next meeting, which will be online, many new members who will vote to maintain DHS's compliance with the 5th Commandment.**

This situation is reminiscent of the BC hospital board elections of the early 1970's which pitted pro-life against pro "choice" candidates. Most of Canada's Catholics were silent.

Silence is consent. Today you and I have a choice. Failure to choose responsibly today guarantees that we will not have a choice tomorrow. Today we can voice our opposition to the BC Government's attempt to force us to kill each other. Tomorrow we may not be allowed to do that.

Please help the Delta Hospice Society by taking out a \$10 one-year membership. If possible, be prepared to attend at least one online meeting to preserve the pro-life purposes of the Delta Hospice Society.
