2. Lorna Cue R.I.P.

On 19th November, we received the sad news from Miss Linda Cue that her twin sister, Lorna, had died. On the previous day, Lorna had received the Last Rites of the Church from Fr. Dean Henderson of Our Lady of the Rosary Parish. Her Funeral Mass was held on Thursday, 26th November, and was attended by the maximum number of ten people as limited by the Ministry of Health. These included a member from our Traditional Latin Mass congregation.

Lorna and her sister were born on 21st May, 1944. When twenty-one years old, Lorna became paralysed in both legs and was confined to a wheelchair. She eventually converted to the Catholic Church and gained much strength from her faith. Lorna was an optimistic Catholic who avoided talking about herself.

For many years, she drove herself in a hand-controlled car. Later, when her car fell into disrepair, she travelled by Handydart bus. She was lovingly cared for by her sister, who was a nurse in the hospital.

Lorna regularly attended the Traditional Latin Mass for many years. About two years ago, her condition deteriorated and she was unable to come frequently, as she was often confined to a hospital. Please pray for the repose of the soul of Lorna. Eternal rest grant unto her, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon her. *Requiescat in pace*: may she rest in peace. Amen.

3. LiveMass.net is an apostolate of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter (F.S.S.P.). The website streams the Tridentine Latin Mass five times each weekday and eight times each Sunday. In addition to Masses, the website also occasionally streams Vespers, Compline, and a Holy Hour. An exact schedule can be found on the website. Select a time which best suits you and your family members as there are Masses starting at different times. All of them are rendered as Pacific Time, which is our time zone.

We recommend that you click on the following link of the Institute of Christ the King, Sovereign Priests (I.C.R.) in Gricigliano where our seminarian Abbé Julian Malinowski is studying <https://www.icrsp.org/direct/>. Its Missa Cantata on Sundays is very beautiful. The Mass is assisted by a number of Altar servers and a small choir. There is no sermon, but a separate link is provided for a sermon in the French tongue. This Mass is not *livestreamed* so that you can follow the Mass at a time of the day at your convenience.)

LITURGY

Sunday 29th November, the First Sunday of Advent, marks the beginning of a new Liturgical Year and the beginning of the Advent Season.

Advent is a penitential time in which we prepare for Christmas in the spirit of prayer, fasting, mortification and works of mercy. This Season begins on the first Sunday of Advent and ends on 24th December.

The important feastdays in December are

- Tuesday, 8th December: Feast of the Immaculate Conception of Our Lady;
- Friday, 25th December: Solemn Feast of Christmas and holyday of obligation;
- Saturday, 26th December: Feast of St. Stephen, Protomartyr;
- Sunday, 27th December: Feast of St. John, Apostle and Evangelist;
- Monday, 28th December: 'Childermas', or Feast of the Holy Innocents.

Masses will be celebrated on all Sundays and the first two (bold-typed) feastdays, if there is to be no lock-down at those times.

Feast of the Immaculate Conception

The Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary on 8th December is the grandest of all the Marian Feasts. Until 1973, this day was a traditional holyday of obligation in Canada.
