Father announced last Sunday that, for the time being, there will be a change in the schedule for weekday Masses. Effective immediately weekly Traditional Latin Masses will be cancelled except for the First Fridays of the month and for some special days. All Souls' Day on Monday, 2nd November, is the first such special day. The reason for this change is the darkness in the early morning which makes driving to church more hazardous for father due to vision impairment.

1. About this Newsletter

We are still not permitted to bring printed copies into the church. When this directive is removed, we will promptly make printed copies available again.

2. Mass Propers

For those who do not have a *Daily Missal* we recommend that you print a copy of the Mass Propers, from the following web site: <https://propria.org/ordo-2020/#October2020>

The Web site which we previous recommended non-sacral English (using, e.g., “you” instead of “Thee” or “Thou”). We have found a web site and ORDO from which both the Latin and Sacral English text can be downloaded or printed directly into a, booklet format. We intend to post the applicable Propers on our website in the near future. Meanwhile you can copy them directly from the afore-mentioned web site. If you encounter difficulty in printing the Propers in booklet format you may call Mr. Peter Stornebrink (250-391-9511) who may be able to help you with the set-up of your printer.

Note that Propers and Commemorations at this web site may not always match those used at our or any other parish as when Priests may, on certain days, choose to celebrate a special Mass, such as a votive Mass. You can sometimes find the Propers of special Masses from the Missalettes on our website and copy the particular Propers for that day. Note that all papers, books, etc. brought to Church must be taken back home after Mass.

3. LiveMass.net

For those who prefer the safety of their home and follow a Latin Mass Livestreamed, we offer the following suggestions. (Note: *Livestreamed* Masses can be followed only at the time when celebrated).

LiveMass.net is an apostolate of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter (F.S.S.P.). The website streams the Tridentine Latin Mass five times each weekday and eight times each Sunday. In addition to Masses, the website also occasionally streams Vespers, Compline, and a Holy Hour. An exact schedule can be found on the website. Select a time which best suits you and your family members as there are Masses starting at different times. All of them are rendered as Pacific Time, which is our time zone.

We recommend that you click on the following link of the Institute of Christ the King, Sovereign Priests (I.C.R.) in Gricigliano where our seminarian Abbé Julian Malinowski is studying <https://www.icrsp.org/direct/>. Its Missa Cantata on Sundays is very beautiful. The Mass is assisted by a number of Altar servers and a small choir. There is no sermon, but a separate link is provided for a sermon in the French tongue. This Mass is not *livestreamed* so that you can follow the Mass at a time of the day at your convenience.)

Liturgy

The most important feastday in November is All Saints' Day which this year falls on a Sunday. All Souls' Day is an occasion of great importance as well, although it is not a feastday. This year a Mass will be offered on All Souls' Day. The colour of the vestments on All Souls Day (November 2nd) is black. The border of this issue of our Newsletter is also black to remind us about the suffering souls. The entire month of November is dedicated to all the Faithful Departed who still are suffering in Purgatory. It is meritorious always to remember them in our prayers. Offering up Masses for them is especially efficacious because Holy Mass is the greatest of all devotions and the highest form of prayer. We should pray and offer up Masses especially for our departed family members, friends, priests, religious and others who have served us in our life.

Please note that the pope has extended the gaining a plenary indulgence, for the release of a soul from purgatory, from the usual octave to the entire month of November. This may be a moot benefit since so few Masses are being offered during the month and Communion on the particular day is one of the requirements. However, it may be useful for some of us. It is troubling that many priests today do a disservice to the dead at funeral Masses by preaching as if the deceased were already in Heaven. First, nobody except God knows the current disposition of the deceased which may be either in Heaven, Hell or Purgatory. We may hope that the soul has already gone into Heaven but it is more likely still to suffer in Purgatory. A positive presumption for any departed removes the incentive to pray and offer sacrifices for the dead.

When the late sister Lucy, one of the Fatima children, asked the Blessed Virgin Mary during an apparition about a deceased relative, a girl of ill repute in the village, she was told she did not go to hell but would suffer in purgatory until the end of time. (Still incomparably better than the eternal suffering in Hell!)

Stories told by an elderly Austrian woman, the mystic Maria Simma, are most interesting and provide a great incentive to pray for the holy souls.
