Please note that **Votive Masses of the Holy Cross** are frequently celebrated in our parish because of the special devotion to the Holy Cross, established since the earliest days of the return of the Traditional Latin Mass in our parish under our former Priest, Fr, Alex MacLellan.

## 4. Support for our Seminarian, Deacon Kent Grealy.

At this time, we suggest special financial support for Deacon Kent Grealy for special financial support. Perhaps you may already have had a chance to congratulate Mr. Grealy. He will be helping out our Traditional Latin Mass congregation in the choir loft and by preaching the Sermons during the month of August

Deacon Grealy will begin his last year of training at the F.S.S.P. traditional seminary in Lincoln Nebraska before being ordained to the priesthood next spring. By that time, he will need to acquire many religious items for administering the Sacraments, especially that of the Holy Eucharist. These include a chalice, vestments and linens, to name a few. Any donations to help Deacon Grealy with these needs will be greatly appreciated. You can hand the Deacon an envelope with your monetary gift after each Mass during the month of August. If you are unable to meet Deacon Grealy then please leave him an envelope at the parish office, duly marked with his name. With our donation we can express our gratitude to our new priests who generously respond to God's call to enter into His service.


### LITURGY

The entire month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus Christ. We may post several Devotions of the Precious Blood of Jesus on our website. The main Liturgical feast in July is that of the **Most Precious Blood** celebrated on 1<sup>st</sup> July. The Feast of the Visitation of our Lady is celebrated on 2<sup>nd</sup> July; that of St. Anne, the mother of our Lady, on 26<sup>th</sup> July (which falls on a Monday this year when no Mass is being offered).

Another feastday is that of **Our Lady of Mount Carmel** celebrated on Friday, 16<sup>th</sup> July.

Note that on the First Friday of the month, July 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Mass will be that of the feastday of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, not the usual votive Mass of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.
