## 4. Pro-Life, Pro-Family and Pro-God

### a. Pro-life political actions

A true Catholic is pro-life and, therefore, will be against abortion and against euthanasia. Being Pro-life implies being Pro-God, since God is both the Creator and Sustainer of all human life. A human life begins at conception when God imparts a soul to a newly formed fertilized ovum. This ensoulment animates that first human cell and begins the process of its replication. It forms the beginning of a new human life. As long as God sustains that natural process, the body is alive and only He has the right to decide on its natural end. (Special cases of self-defense, death-penalty and just-war fatalities are outside the scope of the current, the normal, consideration.)

An election of 338 Members of Canadian Parliament, will be held on Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> September. It is our right and our God-given duty to participate in the election. An election offers an opportunity to elect leaders that are pro-life, pro-family and pro-God. We can and should do our part, through word and actions, to achieve leaders who meet these criteria. We can ask them whether they are pro-life and pro-family and tell them that they ought to be when they are not. We must tell them that God will hold them accountable for their actions. If we can, then we should take part in activities that precede the election. We can attend party meetings, support them financially, participate in demonstrations, display lawn-signs, knock on doors to ask support for pro-life leaders, etc. We have to use our time, talent, and treasure, as

the saying goes, to elect the best leaders. Sitting on the fence amounts to letting the enemy, the anti-life, anti-family and godless or god-hating represent us in parliament. God will also hold us accountable for our inaction.

## **5. Seminarians (A message from the Una Voce Canada (U.V.C.) President)**

The next distribution of funds to the Seminarians, you support (Julian Malinowski and Kent Greal), will occur in early September.

We are supporting 6 seminarians at Our Lady of Guadalupe Seminary (one new one will be starting in the fall) and 1 seminarian at Wigratzbad (FSSP), and 2 seminarians at Gricigliano, Italy (ICRSS). In addition, we are helping one Canadian priest from the latter seminary pay off his seminary fees. In U.V.C.'s 2021 fiscal year (Oct. 1, 2020 - Sept. 30, 2021), we will be donating approximately \$20,000 to help Canadian Traditional seminarians. Each seminarian receives \$1,000 twice a year.

There are two Seminarians from Victoria and consequently \$2,000 will be transferred to them in September. The Victoria funds held in our account now stand at \$196.26 and you may want to consider topping it up 😊

U.V.C. depends on the generosity of our members and our Chapters in order to carry out our work. Without their support none of this would be possible. We would therefore like to ask our chapters to encourage their members to take out a direct membership in UVC and/or consider becoming monthly donors through CanadaHelps. ### The Seven Sorrows of Our Lady



The Blessed Virgin Mary grants seven graces to the souls who honor her daily by meditating on her tears and dolours (sorrows). The "Hail Mary..." is prayed seven times, after each meditation.

### **Here are the Seven Graces**

1. I will grant peace to their families.
2. They will be enlightened about the divine mysteries.
3. I will console them in their pains and I will accompany them in their work.
4. I will give them as much as they ask for as long as it does not oppose the adorable will of my divine Son or the sanctification of their souls.
5. I will defend them in their spiritual battles with the infernal enemy and I will protect them at every instant of their lives.
6. I will visibly help them at the moment of their death, they will see the face of their Mother.

7. I have obtained (This Grace) from my divine Son, that those who propagate this devotion to my tears and dolours will be taken directly from this earthy life to eternal happiness since all of their sins will be forgiven and my Son and I will be their eternal consolation and joy.
